2024 Missional Budget St. Matthews United Methodist Church

Seeking the Kingdom of God, Sharing the Gospel of Jesus Christ, Serving our Neighbors

Your church finance committee worked hard this past year to approve a budget that helps us be effective in making disciples of Jesus Christ for the transformation of the world, as well as be good stewards of the resources God has given us in an everevolving ministry landscape. Join us in this journey of seeking, sharing, and serving as a part of our St. Matthews UMC family!

Priorities

Fuel Discipleship and Evangelism Growth

It was so exciting this year to see the amazing community response to outreach events. Between our Easter Egg Hunt, Trunk or Treat, and Halloween at Browns Park, we were able to reach over 3,000 people. We saw an increase in overall worship attendance both in-person and online and our Wednesday Night Live! Ministries are averaging approximately 80 people each week. We want to do everything we can to keep this ministry momentum going!

Strategically Reduce our Deficit

Our Finance Committee and Trustees have partnered together to create a plan to eliminate our budget deficit over the next three years. By temporarily leveraging our investment funds and decreasing our Annual Conference Apportionment giving, we are working to bring our expenses more in line with our actual income. This year's budget represents a 65% reduction of the deficit we would have faced without making any significant changes.

Diversify our Income Streams

We are so grateful for collaborative partnerships that make our budget possible. We currently lease space at our campuses to Active Imaginations Daycare, St. Matthews Area Ministries, Educare Christian Cottage School, and St. Mark United Methodist Church. We want to continue these partnerships and also pursue other income streams including fundraisers, grant support, and charitable bequests.


God-sized Dreams


