

Tips for Inviting

Be Positive: Think of at least one thing you are excited about in the life and ministries of our church. Whether it's music on Sunday mornings, opportunities for children and youth, loving community, or work we do through St. Matthews Area Ministries, Habitat for Humanity, or our school partnerships... have one thing you're ready to share! Your excitement will be contagious!

It's amazing how invitational we can be about other things and then stay silent about our church.

Be Relational: An invitation to church is always much more natural and sincere when it is someone you have already built a relationship with. Don't let an invitation to church be the first conversation you have with a coworker or neighbor. However, don't make simple questions like, "Do you go to a church in the area?," be more awkward than asking, "Have you been to this restaurant?" It's amazing how invitational we can be about other things and then stay silent about our church.

Be Intentional: Take time to prayerfully consider the specific invitation God is inviting you to make. Could this person need transportation to

church? Would inviting the person to brunch/lunch afterward be a blessing? Is there a specific ministry of our church this person could benefit from instead of just making a general invite? Ask God to guide you as you consider who to invite and how to invite them.

Your personal invitation is likely the most effective tool for bringing people into our church. Studies have shown it is at least 6 times more effective than being invited by the pastor! (umcdiscipleship.org) Who will you invite this Summer? In Christ, Adam

Members of the Prayer Blanket Ministry work hard to choose fabrics that are suitable for all people of all ages.

To get a prayer blanket for someone, simply visit the closet across the hall from Room 204 at the Browns Lane campus. There is an entire shelf of prayer blankets currently available. Use the log to record the name of the person receiving
